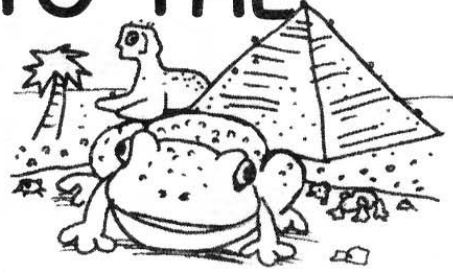


EGYPT GOES TO THE FROGS!



After today's reading, you'll realise how difficult it must have been for the staff of "The Egyptian Papyrus" to get their paper out with frogs hopping and jumping all over the place!

READ EXODUS 7: 25 - 8: 15

Moses waited patiently for God's instructions (v 25).

What was Egypt going to be plagued by now if Pharaoh didn't let the Israelites go (v 2)? _____

What God said would happen (vs 2-4) happened (v 6). Like Mickey Mouse in "The Sorcerer's Apprentice", the magicians did an imitation that multiplied the problem for their master (v 7). They could increase the plague but not reverse it. Only Moses and Aaron could do that. Did Pharaoh really have a change of heart when he told Moses and Aaron that he had enough (v 8)? If he had, it didn't last very long because once the frogs were killed off, he didn't keep his side of the bargain to let the Israelites go (v 15).

The dead frogs symbolised the powerlessness of the two frog-faced Egyptian gods, Hapi and Heqt. God, and not His creatures, is to be worshipped.

WHOM DO YOU WORSHIP? _____

People today may not worship frog-faced idols. They are more likely to worship themselves. If we do not worship the True and Living God who created us, we will be plagued by fear and anxiety. There will be no peace in our lives. Make sure that God is the focus of your life.
